Directions

By Road

From the North

Leave M1 Motorway at Junction 34.

Take the 3rd exit at the roundabout along Tinsley Viaduct.

At the roundabout take the 5th exit (Meadowhall Centre, Attercliffe).

Follow the road to the Sheffield Arena and at the roundabout turn right (Hillsborough).

At the roundabout, go straight on (Hillsborough).

Straight on at the traffic lights.

Fork left at the next roundabout.

At the traffic lights, go straight ahead into Herries Road.

The Hospital entrance is clearly marked on the left.

Once inside the grounds, turn left opposite WH Smith (signposted "UK NEQAS").

The Hospital is well signposted from the end of the Tinsley Viaduct. Follow the sign below.



From the South

Take the 2nd exit (Meadowhall).

Follow the road to the Sheffield Arena and at the roundabout turn right (Hillsborough).

At the roundabout, go straight on (Hillsborough).

Straight on at the traffic lights.

Fork left at the next roundabout.

At the traffic lights, go straight ahead into Herries Road.

The Hospital entrance is clearly marked on the left.

Once inside the grounds, turn left opposite WH Smith (signposted "UK NEQAS").

The Hospital is well signposted from the end of the M1 Motorway. Follow the sign below.

By Rail

The Hospital lies a few miles from Sheffield (Midland) Station. There is a taxi rank outside the station, and the Sheffield Interchange Bus Station lies just across the road.

By Air

The hospital lies fairly equidistant from Manchester, Leeds/Bradford and East Midlands airports. Manchester Airport has a direct rail link to Sheffield (Midland) Rail Station.

Sheffield City Airport with connections to Belfast, Brussels, Dublin and Jersey is a short (10 minute) taxi journey.
